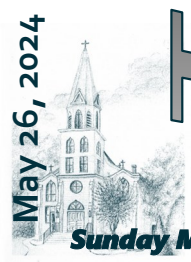

### REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

Holy Trinity Sunday is a day to honor the mystery of the Holy Trinity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This core belief in Christianity reveals that God is three persons in one, emphasizing His relational and loving nature. The Father created the universe, showcasing His power and love. The Son, Jesus, came to earth to teach, guide, and save humanity, embodying divine compassion and sacrifice. The Holy Spirit dwells within us, offering guidance, comfort, and strength.

Reflecting on the Trinity reminds us that we are made for relationships with God and each other. It calls us to live in unity and harmony, just as the three persons of the Trinity coexist. This day also encourages us to embrace the mystery of our faith with humility, trusting in God's infinite wisdom and love. By contemplating the Trinity, we can seek a balanced spiritual life, worshiping the Father, following Jesus' teachings, and being open to the Spirit's guidance. Holy Trinity Sunday deepens our understanding of God's nature and inspires us to reflect divine love in our daily lives.
